### 3. FRIENDLY REMINDER: PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING

- I. <u>The Security/Safety Card</u> is to help the duty teacher to identify your child waiting in the school hall. Please flash or display the card once you have entered the main gate and the teacher will get your child and send him/her to the car. You do not need to come out of your car. This is to prevent holding up your car. To avoid delays, please remember to bring the safety card !!!
- II. <u>Pick up time</u>: Please take note of time your child is to be picked up. Teachers will be on duty for 1 hour only after dismissal time. Time after that is considered late and a fine of *Rm5.00* for every half an hour will be charged. Teacher's time is taken up if you are late. They have to evaluate/assess day's work and prepare for the next day's lesson after their duty. Please call the office if you are going to be late. Teachers will be on duty until 1pm from Monday to Thursday and 12:30pm on Friday.
- III. <u>Taska & Tadika Front Gate</u> will be opened if the weather is very bad. (i.e. heavy rain) <u>Entrance From The Main Gate</u>—please ensure that you park properly and do not block the drive way. We apologise for any inconvenience caused but rest assured that the parking space will be upgraded.
- IV. <u>Label & Tags:</u> Please label or tagging name of your child's on his/her belonging (i.e bags, water bottle, container, etc). This is because it is easier to traced and return them and not accumulate the lost & found items.

## 4. HEALTH CONCERNS—HAND FOOT & MOUTH DISEASES

Please be reminded that the HFMD cases has risen in 2018. The Health Department of Kota Kinabalu has given out circulars for pre-schools to be on the alert and take steps to prevent the occurrence of the diseases. If your child has signs of HFMD please take him/her to see a doctor and medical cert be given to the school. Your child must be kept at home until full recovered. School has to report case to the Health Department.

### **HFMD Symptoms Diseases**

- Fever
- Sore throat
- Feeling of being unwell (malaise)
- Painful, red, blister-like lessions on the tongue,gums and inside the cheeks
- A red rash, without itching but sometimes with blistering, on the palms, soles and sometimes the buttocks.
- Irritability in infants and toddlers
- Loss of appetite
